BEGINNING at an iron stake located in the northern property line of Scotland Street, said stake being South 88 degrees 45 minutes East 196 feet from the point where the northern property line of Scotland Street intersects the eastern property line of North Stewart Street, also being the southeast corner of Lot, No. 94 of the Keith Subdivision as hereinafter referred to and runs thence as the eastern line of Not No. 94 North 1 degree 15 minutes East 105 feet to a stake, the southwest corner of Lot, No. 89 of said subdivision; thence as the southern lines of Lots No. 89 and 90 South 88 degrees 45 minutes East 98 feet to a stake
