Put Social Security Number On Tax Payments To IRS

Greenaboro — So m e North Carolina taxpayers make pay-ments that cannot be properly credited to their account, ac-cording to J. E. Wall, District Director for North Carolina. This happens when a payment is received without an accom-nanying form or notice or bepanying form or notice or be-comes separated from identi-fying documents. Payments that IRS can't

identify are put in a special account until proper identifi-cation can be made, Wall said. This necessarily delays action on that account.

on that account. To avoid such identification problems, Wall asked taxpay-ers to put their Social Securi-ty number on their check or money order. It will also be helpful to note the type of tax and period covered by the pay-ment.

ment Wall said money order stubs or cancelled checks should be kept in case you are requested verify a payment.


