"There is some danger if you were to drink it right out of the dye beck," he said, "But it is not a real threat by the time it gets to the dumping point. Of course I wouldn't want to drink it or swim in it and I don't want anyone else to how to " to have to."

The industry has started building lagoon, Brown said, to act as a holding and settling basin. While it may be a year or two before it is put into operation, he said, eventually the plant will reclaim and reuse its water.

Construction began on April 19 on the 24 - inch sewer line to serve the industry. The contractor has 180 days to complete the entire line although Gaddy said he hoped the portion to Knit - Away would be finished before then.

## Veterans Corner

EDITOR'S NOTE: Below are authoritative answers by the Veterans Administration to some of the many current questions from former servicemen and their families. Further information on veterans benefits may be obtained at any VA office or your local service organization representative.

Q - I am recently discharged veteran. Is there some type of insurance available to me? A -. If you have a service -

connected disability, you may qualify for Service Disabled Veterans Insurance. You must apply within one year of the date of notice that service connection is granted, but you may apply before requesting or receiving a grant of service -connection. Upon receipt of your application for this your application for this insurance, VA will determine if you are eligible. Also a veteran may convert his Serviceman's Group Life Insurance to an individual, permanent policy within 120 days after separation from service.

Q - I want to enter college next summer. Should I advise the VA now, or enroll and advise the registrar of my veteran status at that time.

Another reader, using the monthly telephone rate in Fayetteville, Raeford and Hoke County, and the number of subscribers in each system, estimated approximate cost of being able to reach 1,000 subscribers in Fayetteville is \$.51. In Raeford, the cost is \$7.99 per 1,000 and in the county the cost is \$10.00. "Raeford pays 80% to 90% more for service than Fayetteville," he said. One reader asserted that "I should be able to call all over the county without a

toll," and another said, "In our business and personal phones, the service is very, very poor

The feelings on the question were summed up when one reader said, "As your other reader mentioned, service is awful. Try getting a long distance operator nights or weekends."
