Scouting Around Cape Fear Council

A boy who has completed the 5th grade or is 11 years old, with the approval of his parents or guardian, is eligible to become a Boy Scout, according to W.L. Johnson, President of the Cape Fear Council, Boy Scouts of America. Formerly boys had to be 11 years of age to join a Boy Scout Troop, but the Executive Board of the National Organization has changed the membership requirement so that "A boy is eligible when he is 11 or has completed the 5th grade", Johnson said. The Cape Fear Council which serves New Hanover, Brunswick, Pender, Bladen, Columbus, Robeson, Hoke and Scotland Counties has over 100 Troops. Johnson reported that the Council also expects to organize about 25 new troops in the next three months during the "Fall Round-Up". The Boy Scouts of America is in partnership with local schools, religious institutions, service clubs, civic organizations and other community clubs that are chartered to use the Boy Scout Program, Johnson said. Farm Items

It is almost time to start the "Reduce 6 Pests" campaign in tobacco in Hoke County. This program is effective in controlling three diseases - root knot, mosaic and brown spot and three insect pests, budworms, hornworms and flea beetles. We had more insects this season because we failed to carry out the program last year.

R-6-P is a simple program and all that is involved is destroying the old crop immediately after harvest by (1) cutting or shredding tobacco stalks (2) discing or plowing out stubbles (3) two weeks later discing or plowing under all crop refuse and (4) seeding a winter cover crop.

The goal must be 100% of all tobacco acreage and the slogan is "finish harvest today and cut stalks no later than tomorrow." Let's do the job right in 1971.

Plans should be made to seed fall grazing crops for your livestock. Small grains, ryegrass, and crimson clover are things that can be used. Rye is one of the best small grains for winter grazing. Oats and barley can be used separately or in mixtures with rye. They are usually less productive in the fall, but more productive in the spring. Wheat is usually not used because of Hessian fly problems with early plantings.

In general the winter annuals should be seeded in September in the Coastal Plains. Rates seeded for pure stands are as follows: Rye - 2 bushels per acre, oats 3 to 4 bushels; barley 2 to 3 bushels, ryegrass 30 to 40 pounds per acre and crimson clover 15 to 20 pounds per acre.

Small grains require an average of 500 lbs. of 6-6-12 per acre at seeding and 30-50 lbs. of nitrogen in February or March. Ryegrass uses about the same fertilizer at seeding and nitrogen can be put on three or four times, extending into May. Crimson clover needs 300 lbs. of 0-14-14 or 0-10-20 and works well when overseeded on Coastal Bermudagrass. Good grazing management must be practiced on all the fall crops.
