Tax Course Will Start

A basic income tax course will be conducted here beginning September 13 under the supervision of H&R Block, America's largest tax service, according to Mrs. Edith Best, Hoke area manager.

"The tax course is designed for people who want to save money on their income tax, or make money as tax preparers," said Mrs. Best.

"Anyone may enroll," she continued, "and there are no restrictions or qualifications of any kind. It is not necessary that applicants have any previous financial knowledge or tax experience."

The curriculum provides for a minimum of two three-hour sessions per week for twelve weeks - making a total of 72 hours of classroom work. All instructors are veteran Block employees.

"The course covers all major areas of tax return preparation, with actual practice in preparing individual returns," Mrs. Best said, "and it's programmed to teach the student increasingly detailed tax problems as study progresses."

"We think everyone will find the course interesting and challenging from, beginning to end," said Mrs. Best.

Enrollment forms for the Block income tax course may be obtained by writing, visiting, or phoning the H&R Block office at 529 Harris Ave. anytime before September 13. The telephone number is 875-2244. A choice of day or evening classes will be offered, and certificates will be awarded to all graduates.

Hoke Pays \$369,955

In Taxes

Gross retail sales in Hoke County during 1970-71 amounted to \$16,839,180, according to a report issued last week by the State Department of Revenue.

Gross sales and use tax collections in the county were \$369,955.10.

Of this total, the largest amount of tax was collected; on food - \$144,858.82.

Automotive sales led the list of retail sales, with \$5,476,628 spent. This was followed by food sales of \$5,308,944, general merchandise, \$2,035,404 and autos, \$1,179,528.
