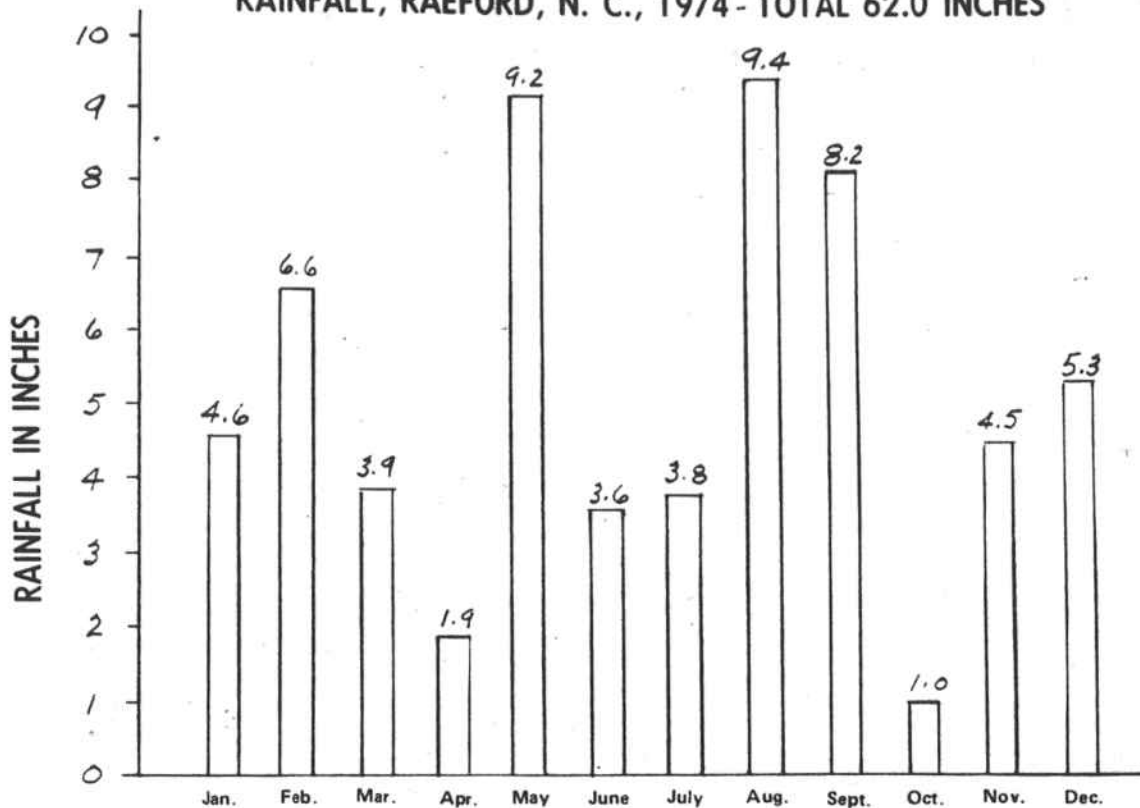
## Missionary Will Speak

The Rev. Clyde Dunn, a native of Mebane, will be the featured speaker at Raeford United Methodist Church on Sunday, Jan. 19 at 7:30 p.m. The Rev. Mr. Dunn served with the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II and after the war was in North China where he became interested in mission service.

## Farm Items

Efficient Fertilization of Tobacco is a bulletin that every farmer should have a copy of in 1975. Costs of fertilizer will be up this year and this bulletin can help you work out the proper nutrients. It also gives information about yields from research that has been done on different types of fertilizer application. It also gives information on leaching and how to correct the amounts lost.

Production of tobacco plants is another bulletin that can be useful. Last year one of the biggest problems in tobacco production, was poor plant beds. This year we must work on this and have strong plants.

Farmers in Hoke County received shortly after Jan. 1, a letter from the Bureau of Census. These forms should be filled out and mailed back as soon as possible. These reports are designed to bring up to date information about agriculture and business in Hoke County. This information is taken every five years. If forms are not sent back, then later the farmer will be visited by a census taker to get the information. So it will be less trouble to you if you mail it back at this time.

Good data is essential for making decisions about farming and this points out changes being made.

The Eighth Annual Membership meeting of the N.C. Soybean Producers Association will be held on Feb. 6 and 7 at the Royal Villa Motor Inn, Raleigh. The informational material and annual meeting will be held all day on the 7th. That night the Soybean Princess Contest will be staged. The Assistant Secretary of Agriculture Richard L. Feltner will be the keynote speaker. Equipment, herbicide selection, nematode selection and insect control will be the main points in the informational program. Farmers are encouraged to register early.
