Notice is hereby given that Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Company (applicant) has made application to the North Carolina Utilities Commission for authority to increase its rates and charges for interstate telephone service in North Carolina. The exchanges are listed below in their proposed rate groups and amounts of increase for each category. The proposed exchange area service (EAS) components included in parentheses are included as a part of the total increase. EAS components are additional monthly charges applicable only to those exchanges which now have local interexchange calling. The existing EAS components are included in the present rates of these exchanges. The increases in the EAS components which are added to the basic group rates increase the billing of such exchange as shown below.
