inappropriate institutional care by providing community based care, home-based care or other forms of less intensive care.

Securing referral for admission for institutional care.

Several services are mandatory, Niblock said, and will be funded under the act. These include family planning, protective care, child placement and day care.

Niblock said the counties, including Hoke, were required to submit plans and cost estimates by March 25. The state must have a plan ready by July 1. A total of \$62.5 million will be available to North Carolina under the act.

Fayetteville SBI office, related he had interviewed about 25 persons in the course of his investigation of the shooting.

Davis testified he took a written statement from Deputy McGuire following the shooting and the statement was read by Davis to the jurors.

Thompson's widow, Betty, was called to the stand and stated she was not aware her husband had a gun. Mrs. Thompson was not at the Evans home when the shooting occurred.

"If I had seen it (the gun) and knew he was heading for my sister-in-law's, I would have called to keep him out of trouble", she said.

Mrs. Thompson testified her husband had a drinking problem, and she described him as "upset" over having to turn in his permit.

Two other Thompson children, Angus, 12, and Mark, 14, did not take the stand.

attended Raeford Institute there and in Athens, Georgia, where his parents lived for awhile. In Athens he attended the Athens Business College and also took courses at the University of Georgia, after which he was Headmaster of Americus Business College in Americus, Georgia.

When he returned to his home in Raeford in 1918, his father told him he had a job for him with the Aberdeen and Rockfish Railroad in Aberdeen as agent. He was hired by the late W.A. Blue, who had succeeded his father, John Blue, as president of the Railroad.

John Blue, founder of the A&R Railroad was still living. Lockey recalls that he took letters in shorthand from Mr. Blue of whom he was very fond. Evidently Blue was fond of young Lockey, for he left some stock in the railroad to him.

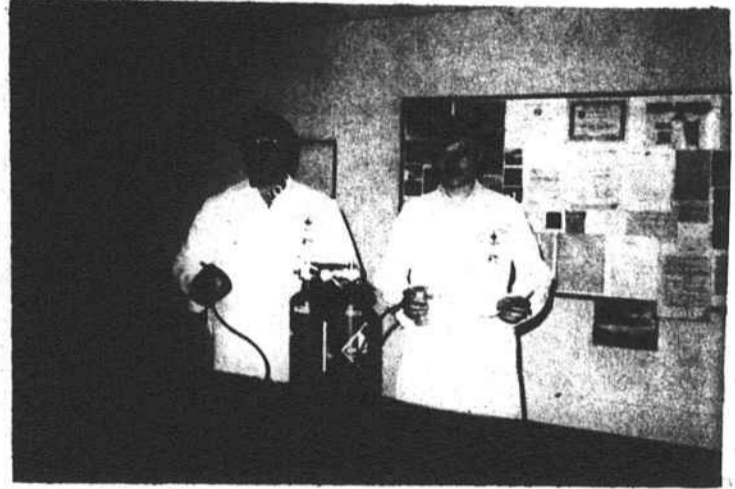
After serving for awhile in Aberdeen he returned to Raeford as agent for the A&R, during which time he recalls he was making frequent trips back to Aberdeen while courting Carrie Hurley, whom he married November 3, 1920.

From depot agent Mr. Lockey was promoted to car accountant, to executive vice president and assistant to the president, and then president and treasurer of the Aberdeen and Rockfish Railroad.

SHAD BAKES

A quarter of a century ago and more under the direction of Lockey, the A&R used to hold a shad bake down the Cape Fear River from Fayetteville, for A&R friends and patrons making the trip on the late Oscar Breece's yacht. Later the shad bakes were moved to the Aberdeen Lake where highway officials and hundreds of other prominent citizens from across the state came to fellowship, talk politics and feast on fresh shad.

While Forrest Lockey is giving up the active management of the Aberdeen and Rockfish Railroad, he has no thought of taking to the rocking chair. Remember, he is still interested in politics and good government.
