

# City Salaries Outlined In Budget Proposal

With annual pay increases cut from the Raeford city budget for next year, most salaries for city employees remain the same as last year's, according to the revised budget proposal scheduled for a public hearing tonight.

Some city workers have been recommended for small increases, or "adjustments", to meet minimum pay standards recommended in a pay plan proposal done for the city by the Institute of Government at Chapel Hill.

John Gaddy is the highest paid city employee, with a \$8,599.89 salary as city manager, and a \$8,599.89 salary as water and sewer administrator for a total of \$17,199.78.

Chief of Police Leonard (Zeke) Wiggins has an annual salary of \$10,449.92.

Chester Beasley receives \$4,999.93 as water and sewer superintendent, and also \$4,999.93 as treatment plant superintendent, for a \$9,999.86 total salary.

Street superintendent Dewey F. Inman receives \$9,449.96.

Zoning administrator William C. Sellers is paid \$8,799.96.

Chief Mechanic Billy H. Barefoot receives \$7,491.90.

The position of municipal garage supervisor, yet unfilled, is budgeted at a \$10,000 yearly salary.

Tax collector Betty Smith receives \$7,139.86.

Pay "adjustments", which are expected to be voted on by the city council, are:

Water and sewer department laborers, salary increase from \$4,804.80 to \$5,148.00; cemetery (laborer) \$4,576.00 to \$4,680; Garbage disposal, (landfill manager) \$4,160 to \$4,680 and (equipment operator) \$4,576 to \$5,148;

Sanitation, (two laborers), salary increased to \$4,680; Street department, (foreman) \$5,408 to \$5,668, (drivers and laborers) four positions raised to \$4,680, one raised to \$4,586, and one position raised to \$4,576.

Salaries for all other city - paid jobs are:

Finance officer, \$6,760; Personnel, payroll, and purchasing clerk, \$5,543.98; administrative assistant, \$6,800; mayor, \$1,500; city councilmen, \$500; police patrolmen, \$8,249.80;

Dog warden, \$3,000; Fire department and radio, (mechanic) \$6,240, (radio) \$4,680 - 5,200 range; treatment plant operators, \$5,886.40-5,990.40, assistant superintendent, \$6,656;

Water and sewer foreman, \$5,928; assistant tax collector, \$5,200; garbage disposal, equipment operator, \$5,200; Sanitation laborer, (two), \$5,033.60 and \$4,576; Street department, one driver, \$4,784.

One vacancy exists in each of five departments, streets, sanitation, cemetery, water and sewer, and treatment plant.

property. Under a bill ratified by the Assembly, boards of county commissioners are authorized to offer and pay rewards of up to \$500.

\*\*\*

The Assembly has enlarged membership of the North Carolina Utilities Commission by two members, to seven members.

Members are appointed to eight year terms by the governor. However, under the expansion legislation, the Assembly gained the right to confirm commission appointments.

The new law also provides that the commission may sit in panels of three, and the three - member panels may make valid and binding decisions. It also requires a separate hearing on electric utility rate increases based solely upon fuel costs.

\*\*\*

The Assembly ratified a bill amending the state Employment Security Law to make teachers with contracts to teach the following school year ineligible for unemployment benefits during summer vacation.

The amended law states that secondary school system employees "shall be considered available for work...only if the individual does not have a contract or contracts, written, oral, or implied..."

Under the ESC statute, persons are eligible for unemployment benefits only if they cannot find work and are available for work.
