## Coach Cites 'Bigger' So. Durham

"They'll be bigger than we are," said Hoke High football coach Bill Cameron as he was referring to the Bucks' game with Southern Durham Friday night.

Cameron seemed to think that the weather would have a lot to do with the game. He said that the Bucks would practice under the lights at Hoke High Stadium most of this week because of the weather.

"The weather will have a lot to do with the ballgame and I think the kicking game will be important also," he said.

Cameron still did not have an official starting lineup for Friday's game but gave a close to accurate account of what the Bucks would probably look like.

He said the Bucks offensive team would probably look like this: Anthony Freeman, fullback; Allen Thomas, tailback; Joe Poole, quarterback; Reginald McRae, Franklin Jordan or Vernon Morrison, wingback; Frank Kicklighter, center; Mike Johnson, Thomas Farmer or Steve Inman, guards; Avery White, Billy Freeman, or Daniel McNeill,

tackle; Ernest Pecora, tight end; and Russell McAllister or Eddie Pennell at split end.

The defensive team would probably look like this: Thomas Farmer, Frank Kicklighter, or Tim Frahm, ends; Avery White, Mike Johnson, or Daniel McNeill, tackles;

Reginald McRae, Keith Floyd or Dick McNeill, linebackers; Alan Thomas, Eddie Pennell, or Vernon Morrison, cornerbacks; and David

Howell and Franklin Jordan, safeties. Cameron said that punter Noah Hendrix is back after an injury.

"Practice has been good and the players have really put forth a good effort considering the weather and the number of players we have," said Cameron.

"The attitude of the team is the best we've ever had," he said.

Cameron said that he is expecting a high scoring ballgame Friday night. Gametime is 8 p.m.

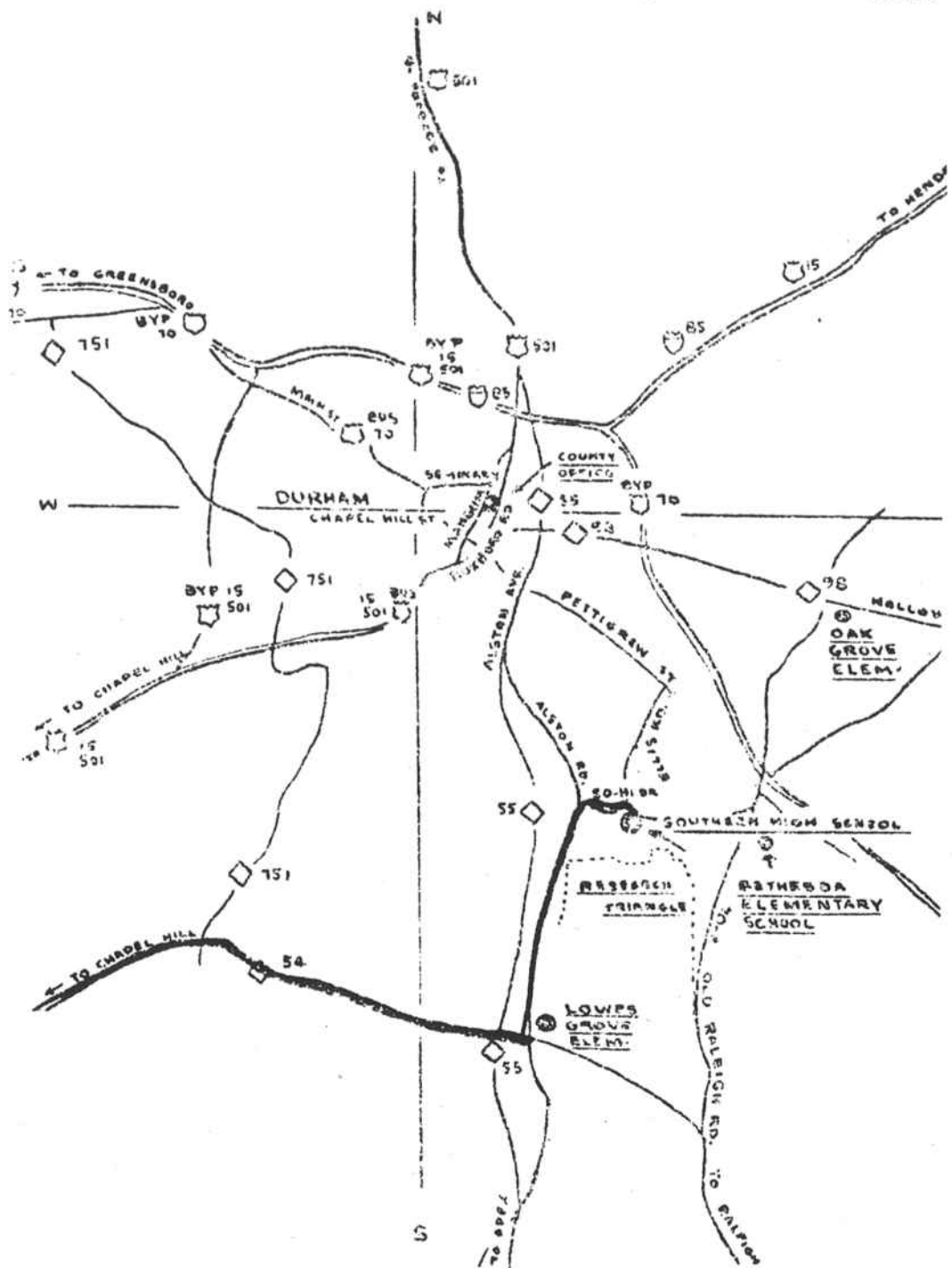
