Coach Cites 'Bigger' So. Durham

"They'll be bigger than we are," said Hoke High football coach Bill Cameron as he was referring to the Buck's game with Southern Durham Friday night.

Cameron seemed to think that the weather would have a lot to do with the game. He said that the Bucks would practice under the lights at Hoke High Stadium most of this week because of the weather.

tackle; Ernest Pecora, tight end; and Russell McAllister or Eddie Pennell at split end.

The defensive team would probably look like this: Thomas Farmer, Frank Kicklighter, or Tim Frahm, ends; Avery White, Mike

Johnson, or Daniel McNeill, tackles; Reginald McRae, Keith Floyd or Dick McNeill, linebackers; Alan Thomas, Eddie Pennell, or Vernon Morrison, cornerbacks; and David Howell and Franklin Jordan, safeties. Cameron said that punter Noah Hendrix is back after an injury.

"Practice has been good and the players have really put forth a good effort considering the weather and the number of players we have," said Cameron.


