Fifth DUI Charge Brings Heavy Fine

A heavy fine was levied by District Court Judge Joseph Dupree here Friday on Larry Kenneth Berry, of 706 Edinborough Ave., Raeford for driving under the influence, (fifth offense) driving while his license was revoked, and speeding 65 in a 55 MPH zone. Berry pleaded guilty to the charges. Dupree sentenced Berry to two years, suspended for five years, and placed him on probation for five years on condition he not drive in any state of the U.S. on a public street or highway for five years and not have the odor of alcohol on his breath during that time, and pay a fine of \$1,000 and costs for the DUI charges. For the other charges, Berry was

sentenced to 12 months, suspended for five years and placed on probation for five years and fined \$500 and costs. The latter sentence is to begin at the expiration of the previous sentence. Carroll Simmons, Fayetteville, pleaded guilty to driving while his license was revoked and driving left of center, and was sentenced to six months, suspended for three and one half years and placed on probation for three and one half years and fined \$200 and costs to begin at the expiration of a previous sentence of six months suspended for three and one half years and placed on probation for three and one half years and fined \$250 and costs for DUI second offense. Blood alcohol content was .19, according to records.

Alfonzo Frazier, Raeford, pleaded guilty to DUI and was sentenced to 90 days, suspended for 12 months, and ordered not to drive for 12 months except for limited driving privileges and fined \$150 and costs.
