Ramsey pitched the first five innings, Jackson the sixth, and McNeill the seventh inning.


The Bucks turned over three double plays during the game as Noah Hendrix led the defensive effort for Hoke.


Hoke played at Red Springs Tuesday and will take on a strong Sanford team tomorrow (Friday) in Sanford.
