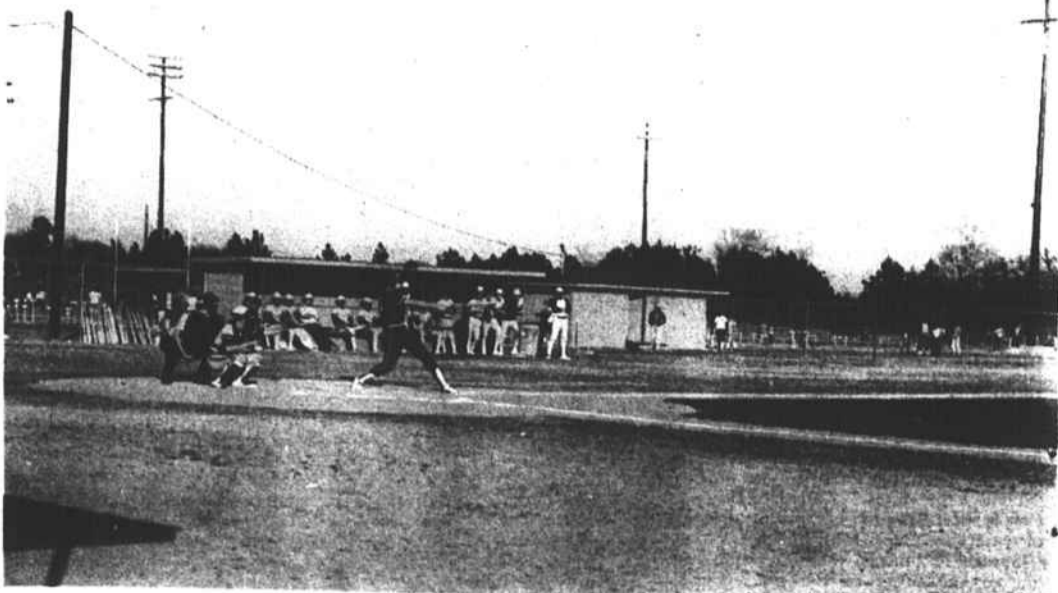
The Bucks jumped to a quick 4-0 lead after the first inning and added one in the fourth and two in the fifth.

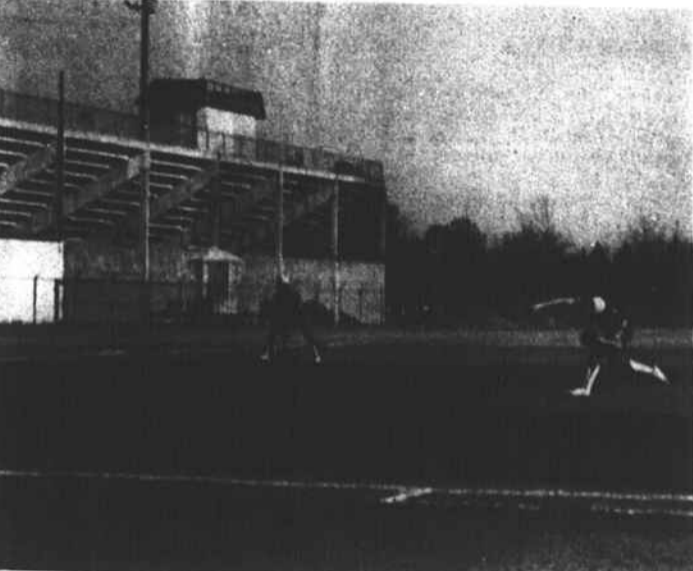
