**Farm Items**

Suppose a tornado, or hurricane were to damage residential structures, businesses and shade trees in your community. Although you are entitled to claim a casualty loss for tax purposes, you must first establish proof of loss. Photographs of your property before it is damaged will be helpful in showing the condition and value of the property prior to the casualty. Pictures before and after the damage has occurred and after the repairs have been made may be helpful. You should make plans to have photographs made of your house and shade trees.

In past years. Growers must produce one acre or more of corn. The field or area must have four straight sides. The corn must be weighed, a sample taken and the moisture corrected to 15.5 per cent. Applications must be postmarked or received prior to midnight November 15, 1976. A local contest committee will be formed if there is enough entries in the county. Measurements must be done by a licensed surveyor extension agent, Vo-Agr. teacher, ASCS representative or another qualified person designated by the committee. One member of the committee must be there at harvest time.

Corn producers can enter the corn contest for 1976. Rules and regulations are similar to the ones

city already has the land for the proposed firehouse. A two and one half acre tract on E. Prospect Ave. was approved by the N.C. League of Municipalities.

The three E's of safety are education, engineering and enforcement. Education is a continuing process and you are responsible to inform your workers on safety. Notice unprotected hazards around the farm and correct these for the engineering part. Also the enforcement of safety codes and practices is your responsibility if you employ farm workers.

"If the bond measure wins approval in August, the construction could start as early as October," he said.  
"However," he continued, "the \$200,000 maximum does not mean that we will sell \$200,000 worth of bonds. The Title I Public Works Legislation passed last Thursday will provide money for public works projects and we hope to qualify for help from this act."

Drumwright noted that the new firehouse might not actually cost \$200,000. Bids will be solicited before selling the bonds so that the exact cost will be known. It is estimated to cost more in the area of \$175,000.

the name was changed to Duke University.

Carolina Power & Light Co. reported earnings of \$2.73 per share of common stock for the 12 months ended June 30.

Andrew Jackson, the seventh President of the United States, at the age of 21, in 1787, received his license to practice law while in Randolph County and practiced in one case at least in Johnstonville, the first county seat in Randolph County.

President Shearon Harris said the figure is up three cents a share from the earnings for the 12 months ended March 31, and is a gain of 29 cents a share from the "depressed earnings" of \$2.44 per share in the 12 months ended June 30, 1975.

Andrew Hoover, the great-great grandfather of the later Herbert Clark Hoover, the 31st President of the United States moved from Maryland to Randolph around 1774. Andrew and his wife are buried at Black Creek in Randolph County.

Harris said that though earnings have improved from last year's depressed levels, they remain below the level state regulatory commissions have said would be reasonable.

Former U.S. Senator Sam J. Ervin, Jr., takes pride in tracing his ancestry back to Randolph County as his maternal great-great-grandfather — Reuben Wood, lived in Randolph County and was a prominent trial lawyer.

Earnings for the second quarter were 61 cents a share, up from 56 cents for the second quarter of last year.

Net income for the 12 months ended June 30 was \$111.3 million on an average of 30.9 million shares outstanding. For a similar period ending June 30 of last year, CP&L reported earnings of \$84.5 million on an average of 25.2 million shares of common stock outstanding.

Harris said a continuation of the increased earnings will assist the company's financial recovery and help regain the company's credit rating, which was lowered in February, 1975 because of inadequate earnings.

"It is most important that we achieve and maintain a level of earnings that will allow restoration of our credit rating," Harris said.
