## New 52 Bed Rest Home Is Viewed By Public

Nearly five hundred persons visited the Open Arms Rest Home on Campus Avenue to view the opening of the brand new 52 bed home completed last month.

Dedication of the new structure, which brings the capacity of the home up to 75 patients, was held Sunday afternoon during an open house hosted by owners John and Kathy Leandro. State personnel are expected sometime this week to inspect the new building and patients

will be moved in as soon as it receives state certification as a rest home.

The new facility, part of a \$400,000 project which also includes remodeling of the old building, is one of the newest and most comfortable rest homes in the area. Patients rooms are decorated in heavy Mediterranean style furniture with a bath between the rooms. Each room have individual heat and air conditioning controls and is furnished with a geriatric chair.

A reception area at the entrance is decorated with velvet covered pieces and the large living room for the residents' use during the day is done in Early American Style.

The dining room in the new building, which seats 76, was designed with tables for four. A small snack area for the patients' convenience is included.

The remodeling of the old building facing Campus Ave. is expected to be completed within the next six weeks.

The Open Arms Rest Home is the only large rest home in the county. Before the completion of the second building, it had been filled to capacity for months.
