A program of wedding music was presented by Miss Mary Lewis, organist, and Joseph G. Davis Jr., vocalist.

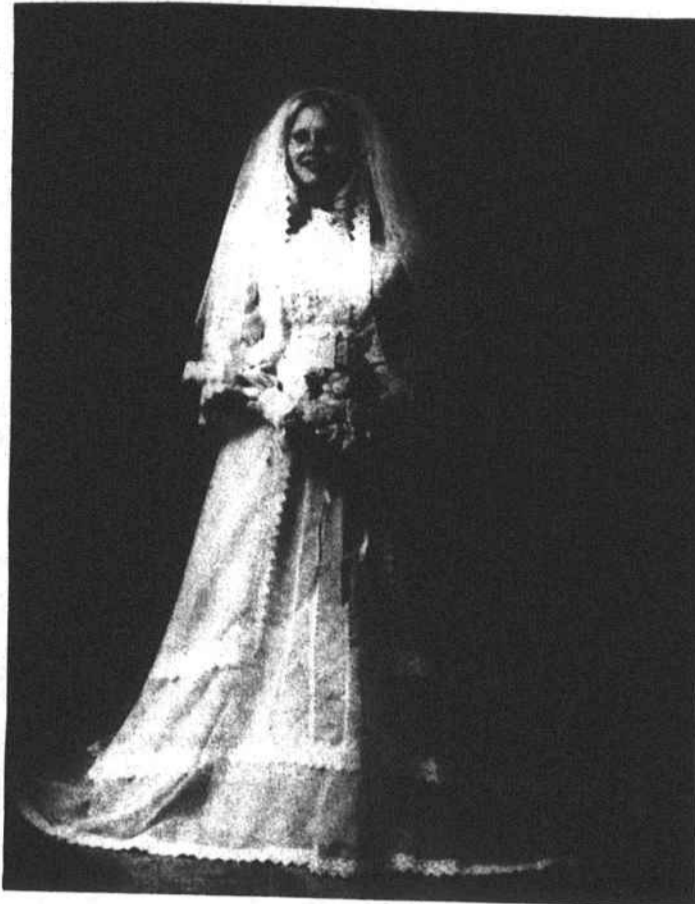
