

Before adjourning, the council also discussed the anticipated cut in the federal public works grant and the effect on the proposed annexation of the College Drive

The city manager said that they can expect only about half of the \$484,000 applied for under the second round of the public works appropriation recently approved by Congress. Drumwright said it would be too expensive to undertake the sewer outfall construction unless the whole project could be completed.

Last year, when the funds were applied for, the plan was to put in the outfall line from S. Main St. near the Summerfield Industries plant, looping it west and north to Hwy. 211 West to take in the College Drive residential area.

Councilmen agreed to wait until June 3, when the North Carolina sub - grants will be announced, before making any decision on altering plans for the project.
