# **SCS** Activities

In the North Carolina summer-time, people's thoughts naturally turn to the great outdoors. Wide use is made of existing recreation areas, whether a big beach or mountain resort, lakes and ponds, hiking trails, campgrounds and similar facilities.

"We also need to be thinking about our future needs in outdoor recreation," said D.R. Huff Jr., chairman of the Hoke Soil and Water Conservation District. What most people do not know is that they have a valuable aid in planning such facilities here in Hoke County." In fact, such surveys have been made for every

county in North Carolina.

The district has a published compilation, complete with maps, that tells about the potential for outdoor recreation. It covers everything from campgrounds to hunt-ing, from fishing to horseback riding, and includes recreation farms, swimming and boating, and a variety of other ways to "have fun in the outdoors" as the chairman
