During summer school, 1,181 students attended in the first five-week session, and 935 attended during the service of the service serv during the second session

The fall semester begins Sunday, Aug. 21, when dormitories will be open for freshmen. On Aug. 22-23 freshman orientation will be held. On Aug. 24-25, registration for all students is scheduled, beginning each day at 8 a.m. in the Jones
