Effects of a given level of aflatoxins on swine can vary because of the condition and age of pigs' quality and quantity of feed, management and environment conditions, and total daily intake of aflatoxins. Younger pigs are usually affected at lower levels than older hogs and breeding stock.

Besides reduced growth rate of loss of condition, signs are rarely seen until abut 7 to 14 days before
