Thacker will be allowed to rent that hangar from the city for \$1 a year for the first five years and for the fair market value the next five years. The motion also included the purchase of three tracts of land needed for further development.

Councilmen Sam Morris and Benny McLeod cast the dissenting votes, according to minutes of the meeting.

VANCE REQUEST

Before the council went into executive session, Gene Vance, owner of Vance Aircraft Sales, requested that the city give him a permanent lease so he could expand his business at the airport to include flight instruction and 'airplane rentals. He told the board that he intended to spend about \$100,000 in expansion.

The city manager argued against Vance's request, saying that more than one fixed base operator at the airport would complicate management of the facility. He told the board that expansion at the airport would mean added cost to the city. The city gets no tax revenues from the airport, he said.

The Raeford airport, which began in the early 1960's as a Chamber of Commerce project. was virtually unused until Gene Thacker began his parachute school there in 1969, according to a report appearing in a back issue of The News-Journal. In 1974, pilots reportedly alleged
