





Jan. 3 — Jan. 31, 1978 **LISTING BEGINS** Tuesday, JAN. 3, 1978 (Due To Holidays)

Notice is hereby given all persons owning Real or Personal Property that they appear before the taxlisters for their township between Jan. 3 and Jan. 31 and make return to them of all property for purposes of taxation. Failure to list will subject taxpayer to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment not to exceed six months. All property owned January 1, 1978 must be listed. All Mobile Home Park and Aircraft Storage Facility Operators must furnish to the Tax Supervisor the name of the owner of each mobile home or airplane and a description of each by January 15, 1978. Extensions for reporting Inventory may be granted upon written request. All mobile home owners must register with the Tax Supervisor's office to obtain a registration decal.

REAL ESTATE

All taxable real property, including buildings and improvements and machinery permanently affixed to the Real Estate.

HOUSEHOLD, KITCHEN FURNITURE, FARM Household furniture and goods, including electrical appliances and tools of trade. All farming equipment, swine, livestock, poultry, farm supplies and farm products produced prior to 1974.
