dent's Commission on Mental Health presented last year to President Carter and their implementation in North Carolina.

be the keynote speaker. The conference is being held in conjunction with the John Umstead Lecture Series sponsored by the N.C. Division of Mental Health and Mental Retardation Services.

The comprehensive report of the President's Commission on Mental Health notes the progress in mental health programming, but also states that many people are still unserved, underserved or in-appropriately served. The Com-mission made hundreds of recommendations to improve mental health efforts in the United States.

North Carolina is the second state in the country hosting a conference for its citizens to address the President's Commission

Sixteen task forces have been formed with over 400 volunteers participating to study specific men-tal health issues which will be presented to conference partici-pants in workshop sessions. Citizens from all over North Carolina will help develop the final recommendations which will be

presented to Governor Hunt.
