# Forgery, Larceny, Drug Cases Heard

The following judgments were issued last week in Hoke County Superior Court. Judge Robert L. Farmer presided.

Ronnie Martinez McLeod, pleaded guilty to six counts of uttering forged checks, four to five years, as restitution or reparation as a condition of attaining work release privilege or parole, the court recommends that the defendant make restitution as follows -- \$45 to A&P, \$45 to Macks Stores, and \$15 to McCormick's Grocery, all of Raeford.

Woodrow Wilson Monroe, breaking or entering, and larceny, pleaded guilty, five years, credited with 21 days spent in confinement awaiting trial; the court recommends work release when the defendant has complied with the rules and regulations of the Department of Correction.

Paul Ransom, Box 155, rural route, Raeford, breaking or entering and larceny, pleaded guilty, prayer for judgment continued till the week of January 18, 1982.

Larry Felder, breaking or entering and larceny, pleaded guilty, five years, credited with 21 days spent in confinement awaiting trial; court recommends work release when the defendant has complied with Department of Correction rules. Pro-

bation violation, suspension ordered revoked and defendant be imprisoned for a maximum of two years, with 67 days' credit given for time spent in confinement awaiting trial.

Mary Evelyn Mull, Rt. 2, Raeford, pleaded guilty to misdemeanor possession of a controlled substance, misdemeanor possession of a syringe, and felonious possession with intent to sell and deliver a controlled substance, two years, suspended for three years, probation for three years, \$200 fine and costs in one case.

Benjie Allen Stephens, violation of probation, probation revoked, former suspended sentence of five years as a committed youthful offender modified to imprisonment for a maximum of five years, with credit for 105 days confinement

pending trial.

Donald Ray Butler, larceny, found not guilty by a jury.

John Wesley McLean, possession of a controlled substance with intent to sell and deliver, pleaded no contest, two to four years, suspended for three years, probation for three years, \$250 and costs.

Ronald McPhaul, breaking or entering of a motor vehicle, pleaded guilty, two years; as to restitution or reparation as a condition of attaining work release privilege or parole, the court recommends the defendant make restitution of \$139.20 to Enois Thomas Lemons, Rt. 1, Lumber Bridge; larceny, voluntary dismissal by the prosecutor; defendant pleaded guilty to a related felony, breaking or entering of a motor vehicle.

## Hoke ASCS

On Friday, November 27, the Hoke County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service Office will mail election ballots to all known eligible voters for the upcoming Community Committee election.

Persons receiving ballots will be asked to vote for a maximum of three candidates to serve as ASC community committeemen for the community in which they live. Once the voter has made his or her selection, it is necessary that the ballot be returned to the ASCS office no later than the close of business on Monday, December 7.

On Monday, December 14, at 9 a.m., the incumbent county committee will meet in the Hoke County ASCS Office to tabulate the results for the purpose of determining those candidates elected to serve as ASC Community Committeemen.

In conclusion, the newly elected community committee will meet at 10 a.m., Monday, December 21, in the Hoke County ASCS Office to conduct a county convention in order to select committeemen to fill vacancies on the County committee.

In addition to filling vacancies on the convention those delegates present will select a chairman, vice chairman and two alternates to the committee.

All eligible voters of the Hoke County ASCS election are strongly urged to vote for the candidate of their choice.

Both the tabulation of ballots on December 14th and the county convention on December 21 will be open to the public for all interested individuals wishing to attend regardless of race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

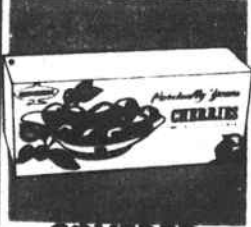

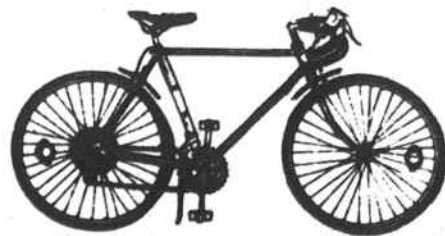
