Noble is serving his first regular Senate prior to the 1980 election by appointment to fill the vacancy
created by the death of State Sen Luther Britt. He was unopposed
for election in 1980 .

Parnell is a Parkton businessman and a farmer and is serving his
fourth term in the State House of Representatives.
In the 1981 General Assembly, he served as chairman of the
House Base Budget Committee on General Government and was reported to have been instrumental
