No change in the place or time of the meetings may be made without previous advertising in local news-papers and on local radio. The common agenda for the March meetings also provides for

the election of officers to fill any vacancies that have occurred on precinct committees since the 1981 organizational meetings.

Also on the calendar of events released by Walker are a make-up date, March 18, for precincts that fail to meet on March 11; the county conventions on April 3; district conventions on May 15; and the Democratic State Convention on June 12.

Delegates from North Carolina will also participate in the National Democratic Party Mid-year Conference in Philadelphia on June 25-26.




