

**In District Court**

**DUI, Check, Assault Cases Are Heard**

The following judgments were issued Thursday in Hoke County District Court, Judge Joseph E. Dupree presiding.

Robert Lynn Johnson, Star Route, Robbinsville, driving under the influence, second offense, and driving while license revoked, two years suspended for three years, probation for three years, \$500 and costs, and not drive unless or until properly licensed.

John Michael Russell, Charlotte,

speeding 65 in a 55 zone, prayer for judgment continued, costs.

Bucky Reid Beasley, Rt. 1, Box 119, Lumber Bridge, driving under the influence, pleaded not guilty, found guilty of driving with a blood alcohol reading of .10% or more, 30 days suspended, \$125 and costs, and complete successfully within 75 days the Drug and Alcohol Abuse School.

Jackie McNair, Rt. 3, Box 25E, Raeford, obtaining property with a

worthless check, 181 days, suspended for two years, probation for two years, \$25 and costs, and \$26.48 restitution to Howard Clothiers.

James Douglas McQueen, Charlotte, speeding 70 in a 55 zone, prayer for judgment continued, costs.

Kenneth Marvin Norris, Fayetteville, speeding 65 in a 55 zone, voluntary dismissal by the prosecutor; exceeding a safe speed,

costs. Sgt. Toney Myers Lisbon, Fayetteville, speeding 70 in a 55 zone, \$25 and costs.

Lorenzo Murchison, Raeford, assault on a female, prayer for judgment continued, costs.

Juanita Blue Malloy, P.O. Box 411, Raeford, failing to drive on the right, and failing to stop at the scene of an accident, 181 days suspended for two years, probation for two years, \$100 and costs.

Friday's judgments follow. Robbie N. Hammonds, Rt. 1, Box 178, Shannon, larceny of a motor vehicle, 181 days, credited with time spent in jail.

Virginia Baker Scott, Rt. 3, Box 252-K, Raeford, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of Diethylpropion, marijuana and oxycodone, two years; the court recommends the Department of Correction give the defendant whatever therapy they may have to

offer in regards to drug addiction; defendant gave notice of appeal.

David Bruton, Rt. 1, Lumber Bridge, nonsupport, prayer for judgment continued, costs; costs remitted; case referred to attorney for civil processing.

Benny Henderson, Rt. 1, Box 117A, Aberdeen, assault with a deadly weapon, prayer for judgment/continued on condition the defendant not assault Elaine Henderson and not communicate with Elaine Henderson; and pay court costs.

Gloria D. Robinson, P.O. Box 1151, Raeford, food stamp fraud, and failing to disclose a material fact, resulting in obtaining and continuing to receive assistance to which the defendant was not entitled, in the amount of \$904, from the Aid to Families with Dependent Children program, from May 1, 1981, to September 30, 1981, waived probable-cause hearing.

Mary Odum Mull, Scotland Acres, Laurinburg, possession of Methaqualone, possession of drug paraphernalia (gummed cigarette papers), careless and reckless driving, and possession of marijuana, two years, suspended for five years, \$500 and costs, and violate no narcotic control law of the state for five years; driving under the influence of a narcotic drug, voluntary dismissal by the prosecutor.

Nathaniel Watkins, Rt. 1, Box 122-N, Lumber Bridge, worthless checks, 30 days suspended, \$20 restitution to McCormicks Grocery, and \$22.72 restitution to The Party Shoppe, and costs.

Ervin Lee Everett, 1531 Pine Haven Circle, Raeford, speeding 45 in a 35 zone, pleaded not guilty, found guilty, prayer for judgment continued, costs.

**Nursing Course**

The School of Nursing at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in collaboration with the Fayetteville Area Health Education Center is planning to begin in August 1982 the first of 10 courses leading to a Bachelor of Science in nursing degree for registered nurses in the FAHEC region.

The courses are open to RNs who have completed the pre-requisite arts and science courses at a community college, junior or senior college or university.
