# Hoke Track Team Wins First In 3 Years

The Hoke County High School boys' track team won its first meet in three years last week, defeating Lee County 80-56.

The Bucks have one loss for the season to date. Their third meet is on Thursday with Terry Sanford at the latter's field.

Robert Moody led the winners with 11 1/4 points. Paul Hunt was

next with 10, and Ronnie McRae got 8.

Hunt won the mile and two mile runs. Moody won the high and intermediate hurdles and also was on the winning mile relay team, whose other members were Jerry McMillan, David McMillan and Willie Bridges. The winning relay time was 3:45.4.

McRae won the 800 meter run and was second in the mile.

The Hoke mile and 800 meter relay teams won their races. The members of the 800 team were Jerry McMillan, Lowell Simmons, Willie Bridges, and Ricky McNeill. Their time was 1:36.9.

Children must be between the ages of 5-15. Each child must bring a bag lunch, drinks will be provided. If you are interested contact the Parks and Recreation office.

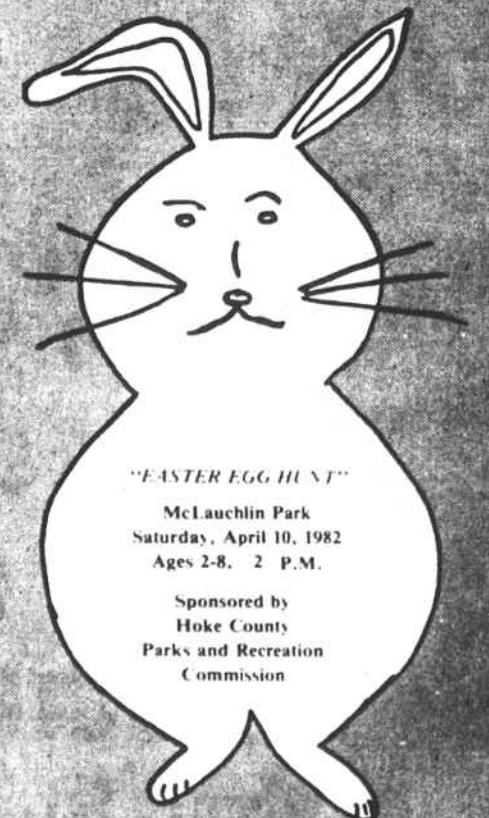
## Spring Flea Market
