

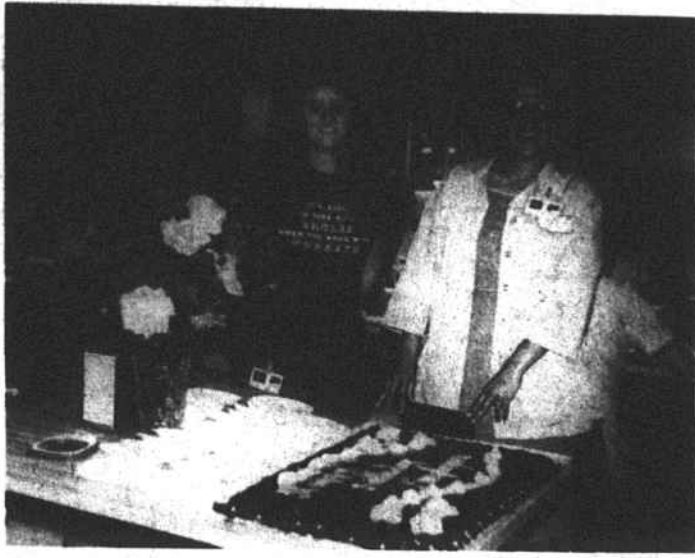
May Birthday Employees Feted

The eighth commencement exercises of Flora Macdonald Academy were held in the school auditorium on Thursday, at 8 p.m.

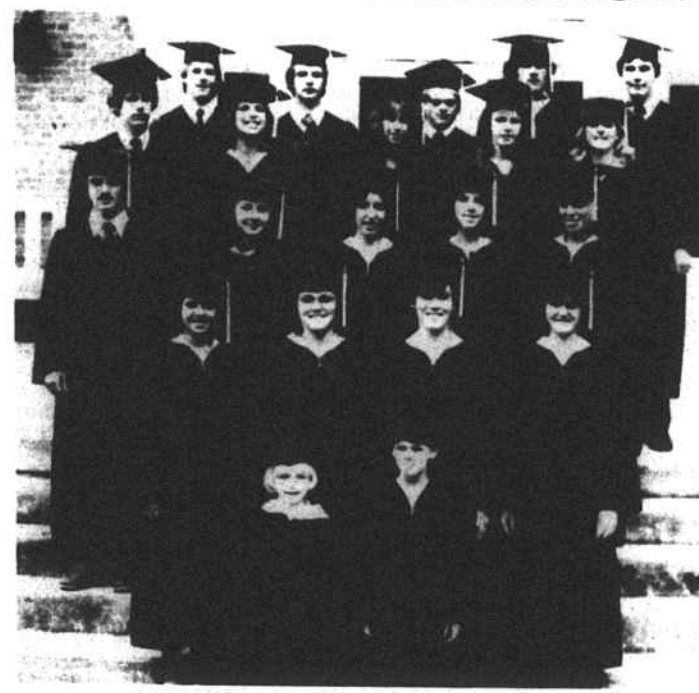
Mary Faye Williamson, a former English and Latin teacher of the school, delivered the graduation address.
