institutions' building permit fees already paid, should the Baptist church be allowed a refund?

City Manager Ron Matthews earlier in the meeting informed the council that the city will receive no state help for establishing its industrial waste-water pretreatment program but that the program has been mandated:

He said it would take \$15,000 to \$20,000 to develop the program but that the state could be challenged on the refusal of assistance since the city is doing what it is being required to do but using a different method; consequently, it qualifies for state help.

The subject was tabled temporarily for further exploration.

The council also during the meeting agreed that Mayor John K.
McNeill, Jr., should present to the State Department of Transportation on July 29 the city's message: to put the four-laning of U.S. 401 from the northern city limits to the Cumberland County line back in the DOT construction program for 1983.

The July 29 meeting is for the counties in highway Division Eight and will be held at Montgomery Technical Institute near Troy, starting at 2 p.m. It is one of a series of public meetings scheduled throughout the state for this month to update the 1982-1991 Transportation Improvement Program.

Earl Fowler, executive vice president of the Raeford-Hoke County Chamber of Commerce, stimulated the council's action when he told the council the four-laning project had been removed recently from the DOT list for the next 10 years.

Besides the mayor, Fowler and City Manager Ron Matthews will attend the Montgomery County meeting. The Hoke County government will be represented at the meeting by County Manager James Martin and probably one or more county commissioners.

During the Monday night meeting also the council adopted a motion to accept a recommendation of the City Planning Board that a request to rezone a South Main Street area to C-2 commercial from Residential-8 be granted.

Upchurch made the motion to accept after the council was informed that the rezoning was wanted so a Federal Land Bank-Production Credit Association building could be established on the property. The council was informed by Julian Butler, representing the organization, that PCA-FLB does a low-volume business. This indicates traffic volume in the area won't be increased significantly by the introduction of the business.

The council also adopted a motion to accept a Planning Board recommendation to approve a planned subdivision to be developed by Avery Connell on North Fulton Street.


