Free Play Gym

The Hoke County Parks and Recreation Commission has Gibson Gym at Hoke High open for free play basketball Monday-Friday, 10 a.m.-noon, and from 1-6 p.m. Weekend hours must be reserved through the Hoke County Community School Director. The program will conclude on August 6.

Youth Football Physicals

All boys interested in playing midget football this fall in the Hoke County Parks and Recreation Commission league are required to obtain a physical. The Hoke County Health Department will be giving free physicals to all interested participants on Tuesday, August 3, 9, 16, 23 and 30 from 1 p.m. until 4 p.m. Appointments are required, and a parent or a guardian must accompany the child. You must bring your shot records if you have not previously visited the Health Department. Physical forms may be obtained at the Recreation office or at the Health Department. To be eligible for the Midget Football League you must turn 10 before October 1, 1982, and must turn 14 on or after April 1, 1982. Also you must weigh at least 65 pounds and no more than 125 pounds.
