


Hoke Co. Child Care Food Program Renewed

Head Start enrollees in Hoke County will again have the opportunity to participate in the Child Care Food Program during the 1982-83 program year.

The program is being sponsored by Four-County Community Services, Inc. under an agreement with the Division of Child Nutrition of the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction.

Meals will be available to children who are enrolled in Head Start centers and who meet eligibility requirements, without regard to race, color, national origin, sex or handicap.

The sponsoring agency operates centers at the Hoke Head Start Center one and two on Turnpike Road in Raeford.

The Cereus blossoms come out at about midnight and stay out for about six hours, then close up again.
