

Hoke Superior Court Judgments Are Issued

The following judgments were among those issued during the September 20 term of Hoke County Superior Court by Judge Sam Britt of Lumberton.

The other judgments were published in previous editions of *The News-Journal*.

Steven Ronald Francis of Rt. 1, Box 397, Raeford, was sentenced to 24 hours in the Hoke County Jail after he pleaded guilty to speeding 48 miles per hour in a 35 mph zone. He had appealed to Superior Court from a District Court judgment of a \$10 fine plus court costs

for the traffic violation.

Kathleen Talbot of 514 E. Fifth Ave., Raeford, was sentenced to 30 days suspended on condition she make restitutions of \$28.43 and \$141.27 to Bobby Lentz of Jackson's FMA, and pay court costs. The judgment was on two counts of

obtaining property with worthless checks. She had appealed from a District Court sentence of 181 days in prison.

Rocky Dean Locklear of Rt. 1, Shannon, was sentenced to six months suspended for five years on condition he pay \$80 per month for

support of his illegitimate child, and pay court costs. Locklear was found guilty by a jury of a charge of nonsupport of the illegitimate child. He had pleaded not guilty.
