### Ready-mix Concrete Plant Opens Here

The Raeford plant, the fifth in the company's chain, is located off Stewart Street near Hoke Concrete Works, a concrete block producer, from whom Commercial bought

Crumpler said the Raeford plant has three 10-yard-capacity mixer trucks and has up to 50 more available from Commercial's other plants, which are at Monroe, Wadesboro, Rockingham and Laurinburg. The home office is in Monroe.

He said the local plant has a production capacity of 100 cubic yards

of ready-mix concrete per hour. Wade Mace is the plant manager. The local office will employ five people initially and extend operations later to cover other products. He said the plant will sell to con-






