The drive, being conducted by the society, was started this month.

Mrs. McGinnis advised people interested in contributing to make checks payable to the County of Hoke and to specify that the donation is to be used for the new pound. The donations are tax-deductible, Mrs. McGinnis added.

A new pound will cost about \$27,000, it has been estimated. The City of Raeford has \$7,000 in its budget for the city's share of the cost, and the county government would be responsible for providing the rest.
