Although <br> lina could not be punished. nevertheless held that an attempted suicide was a misdemeanor in the suicide was a misdemeanor in the state and could be punished by fine or imprisonment. <br> trial court for further proceedings. <br> As reported earlier in this column, the North Carolina Gen- eral Assembly abolished the com- mon law crime of suicide in 1973. It made no mention. however. about whether the crime of at- tempted suicide. which the Su- preme Court had recognized in the 1961 case, was also abolished. However. if one argues that an attempt to do an act which is no longer criminal can certainly not logically be a criminal attempt. then an attempted suicide is no longer a criminal offense, and the 1901 Supreme Court case is over- ruled by implication. After all, the Supreme Court's decision confirming attempted sui- cide as a criminal act was based on the existence of the crime of suicide in North Carolina; once the crime of suicide is abolished. the basis for holding an attempted suicide as
