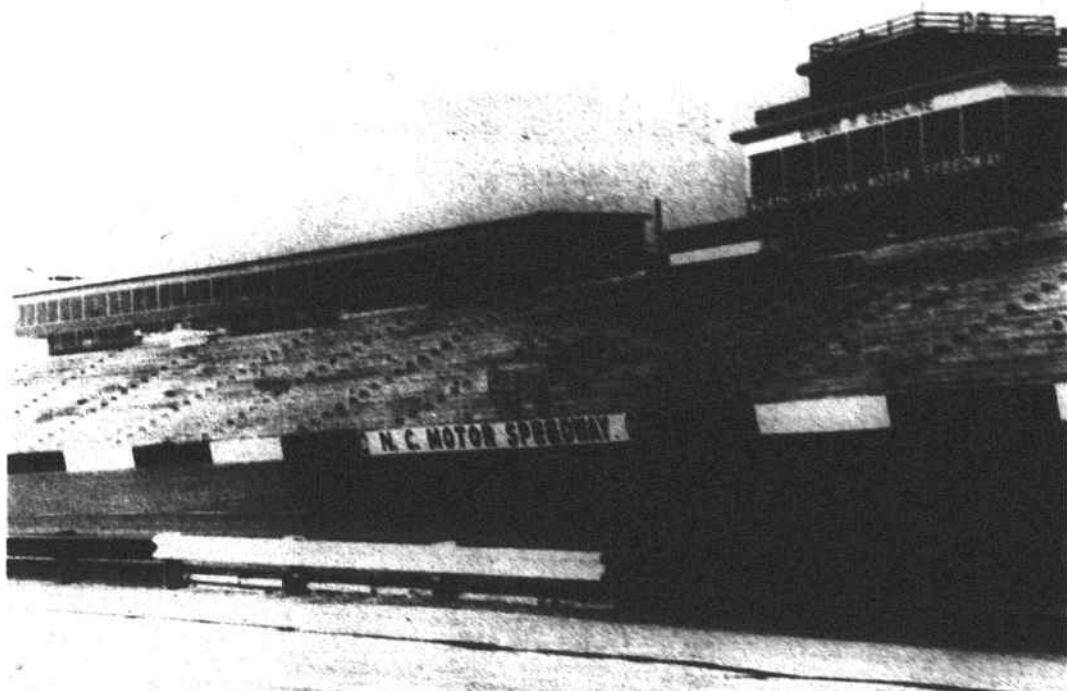

## Free Map Available For National Forests

A new National Forest visitor guide map has recently been printed by the National Forests in North Carolina.

This map includes all four National Forests; from the Croatan on the coast, the Uwharrie in the Piedmont, to the Pisgah and Nantahala National Forests in the western mountains.

Incorporating all major highways and secondary roads for the areas around New Bern, Troy and Asheboro, Brevard, Marion, Hot Springs, Burnsville, Franklin, Highlands, Robbinsville and Murphy where National Forests exist, this map locates and describes 76 significant recreation opportunities on the 1,200,000 acres of National Forest lands in North Carolina.

From the Tideland Trail at Cedar Point on the eastern-most Croatan National Forest to the Joyce Kilmer Memorial Forest and Slickrock Wilderness Area on the Tennessee-North Carolina line in the west, this map includes campgrounds, picnic areas, trail, swimming and boating opportunities, waterfalls, etc., with each area located and listed by the opportunities available. Historical and background information on other National Forest features, such as the Cradle of Forestry, is also included.

In handy pocket-size, this map is now available free at the National Forests in North Carolina headquarters at 50 South French Broad Avenue, P.O. Box 2750, Asheville, North Carolina 28802. Copies may be ordered by mail.
