Lamonaco was one of New Jersey's most highly decorated

As a result of the investigation into the shooting, felony murder warrants have been issued for the arrests of: Thomas William Mannarrests of: Thomas William Manning W-M 36, 5'10", 150 lbs., brown hair, hazel eyes, place of birth Boston, Ma., and Richard Charles Williams, W-M, 34, 6'0", 200 lbs., brown hair, blue eyes, place of birth Beverly, Ma.

Also wanted for questioning is Raymond Luc Levasseur, W-M, 35, 6'0", 200 lbs., DOB: 10-10-46,

Jackson Unit (SM-JJU) that evolved from a prison reform group.

Their specialty allegedly is armored car, and bank robberies.
Investigation has indicated that SM-JJU has some affiliation with such better known terrorist groups at the Weather Indicated as the Weather Underground, and the Black Liberation Army.

On February 7, 1982, near Boston, two Massachusetts State Troopers became involved in a shoot-out when they checked a vehicle occupied by two known associates of the Manning, Williams, Levasseur group.

The suspects are Jaan Karl Laaman, W-M, 5'10", 200 lbs., DOB: 3-11-48 in Muenster, Germany and, Christopher Everett King, B-M, DOB: 2-11-50 in Baltimore, Maryland. King has been apprehended, Laaman

The fugitive's life style can be onsidered communal. They prefer renting in rural areas such as farm houses. However they will easily adapt to urban living if the need arises. They generally keep to themselves, not socializing with neighbors.

Manning and his wife Carol have three children; Jeremy W-M 8 yrs. DOB: 11-16-73 & 4-2-74, Tamara W-F3 yrs., DOB: 6-30-79, and Jonathan W-M DOB:

Williams is not married but has two children who are living with their mother.

Manning and Levasseur are on the FBI's 10 most wanted list; Manning and Williams on the New State Police 12-most-Jersey

There is a \$25,000 reward from the State of New Jersey for the arrest of Manning and Williams.
