## Jobless Rate Dips Slightly

Although 60 county residents found work during March, figures released this week by the state Employment Security Commission show the number of jobless here remained the same as the previous month.

Because of the increase in work force, the employment rate decreased a percentage point from 11.8 to 11.7 during the month, the figures show.

Of the 7,930 in the work force,

Of the 7,930 in the work force, 7,000 people in the Hoke area had jobs in March while in February there were only 7,870 people in the work force and 6,940 individuals working.

Four of the five surrounding counties decreased their jobless rate with Hoke being the county with the lowest decrease for March.

Of the adjoining counties, Scotland's jobless rate increased by 2% coming in at 11.6% in

by 2% coming in at 11.6% in March and 11.4% in February. Richmond County enjoyed the largest decrease in unemployment of the six counties in the surroun-

The statewide unemployment rate dropped from 10.2% in Febraury to 9.8% in March while the national toll fell from 11.3 to 10.8
