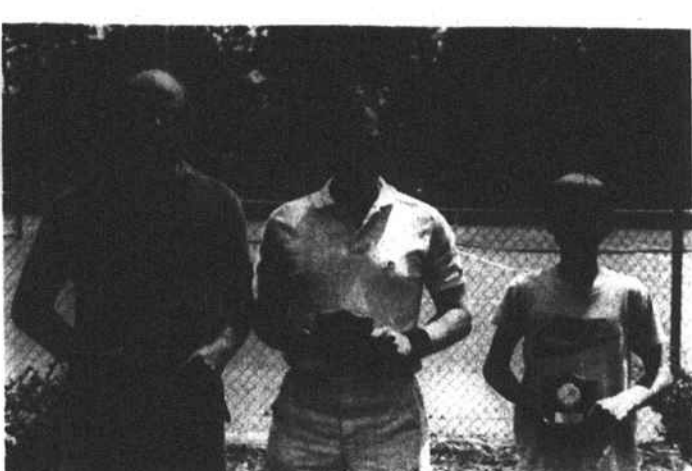

Jr. Tar Heel Baseball (Note Correction)

The Parks and Recreation Commission is organizing a Junior Tar-Heel Baseball League for all interested participants ages 13-15.

Players eligible are those whose 15th birthday comes on or after August 1, or those whose 13th birthday comes on or before August 1.

The sign-up will take place on Saturday, May 14 at 9 a.m., at Upchurch Baseball Field. All potential players must bring their birth certificates even though they have participated in a Parks and Recreation sponsored athletic program prior. We are preparing for four teams in this year's league. All sign-ups will be on a first come first serve basis.

Little League Baseball

To be eligible for T-Ball all players must turn 7 before August 1, and must turn 10 on or after August 1. All potential players must bring their birth certificate even though they have participated in a Parks and Recreation sponsored event prior.
