

There will be an Organ and Voice recital given by Ashley Burell and Lester Southern, Sunday, July 31, 4 p.m., at the Raeford Presbyterian Church. Burell will accompany Southern and perform the following organ works: Fugue a la Gigue (David N. Johnson); Morning Has Broken and Now Thank We All Our God (Paul Manz); Prelude and Fugue in G major (J.S. Bach); Sonata I: 2nd and 4th Movements (Felix Mendelssohn); La Fileuse (Marcel Dupre); and God Among Us (Olivier Messiaen). Mr. Southern will be singing sacred vocal selections consisting of the following: Lord God of Abraham and It is Enough from Elijah (Felix Mendelssohn); The Call (Ralph Vaughan Williams); In God is my Salvation (Richard Purvis); The Trumpet Shall Sound from Messiah (G.F. Handel); Were You There and The Blind Man Stood on the Road and Cried (H.T. Burleigh). Burell is the Organist-Choirmaster at the Raeford Presbyterian Church. He has a Masters' of Music Degree in Organ Performance from the University Montevallo, (Montevallo, Alabama). Admission to the recital is free and the public is cordially invited to attend




