FLU SHOTS
The Hoke County Health Department will soon be administering a protective flu vaccine to "high risk" individuals - those 65 and over, and those of any age with certain medical conditions.

There are many persons in the high risk category who will be especially vulnerable to complications from a flu attack. Some of the medical conditions in the high risk group are chronic heart disease, bronchitis, tuberculosis, emphysema, kidney disease, diabetes and chronic anemia.

Anyone with one of these medical conditions should consult his family doctor as to the need of the flu shot. The Health Department will offer the flu shots on Tuesdays from 8 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., beginning Tuesday, October 19th, 1993. There will be a \$5.00 charge for the shot.
