

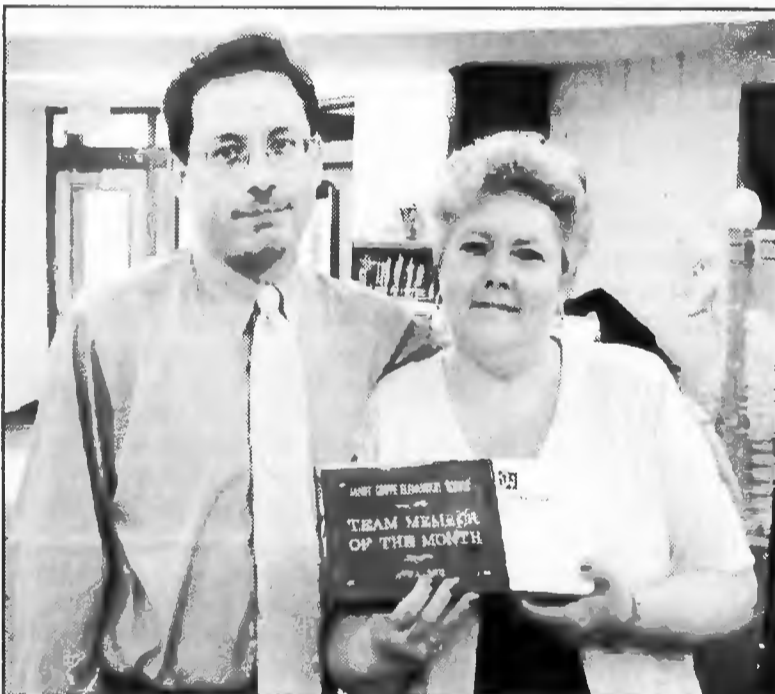

## Hoke High Underclassmen Awards presented

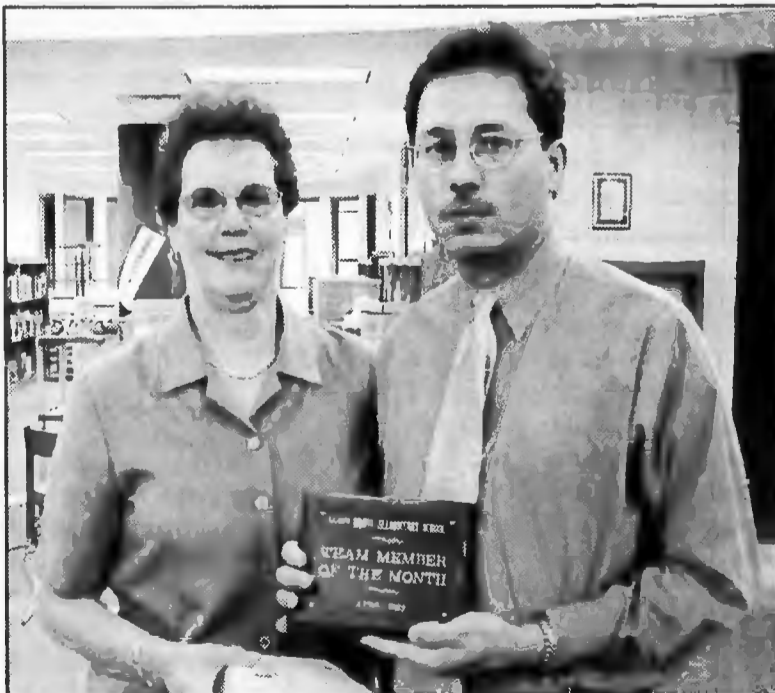
