East beats West in Battle of Books



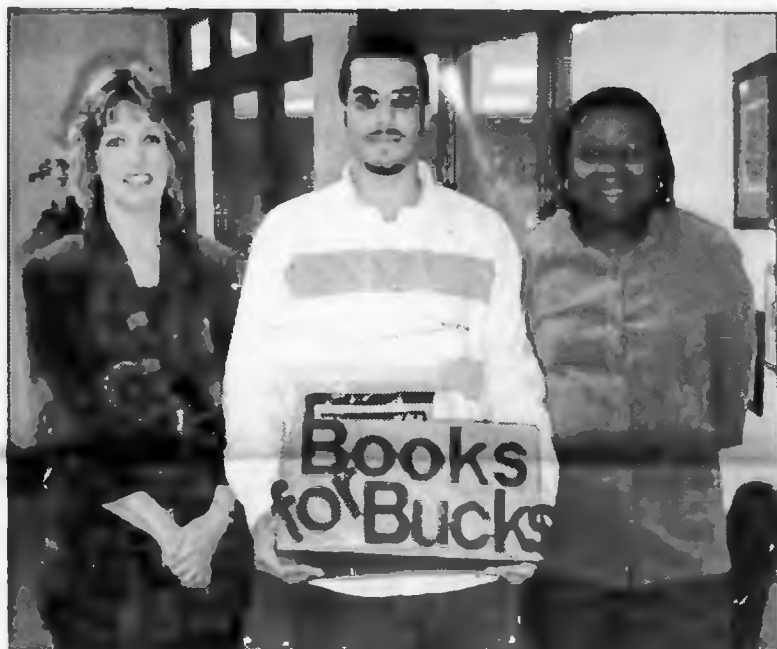
Top photo — the victorious East Hoke Middle Battle of the Books team. Bottom — the West Hoke Middle team.
