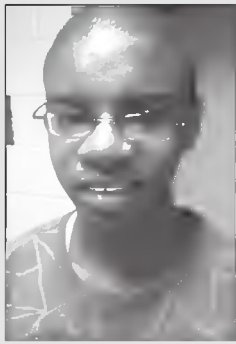

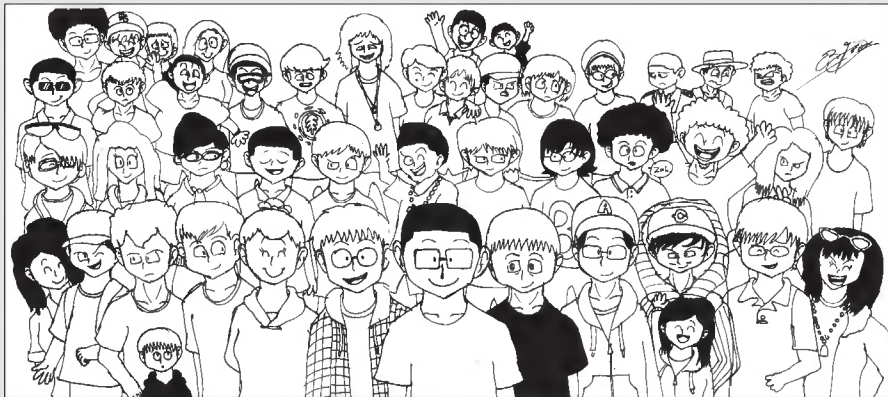
Cartoonist starts 'Screech' strip

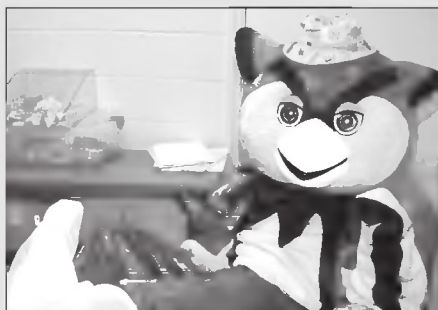

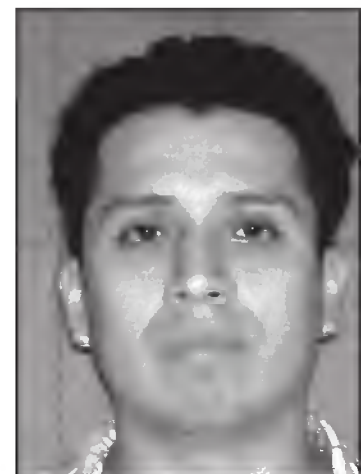
