DOG TAX.

A tax upon every dog kept in the city limits is due and payable to the Chief of Police on the first day of July in each year. All persons owning a dog who shall fail to pay the tax during the month of July, or who shall keep upon their premises an unlicensed dog after the 1st day of August, shall be subject to a fine; and all persons who shall fail to give in their dogs shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and fined \$5 for each dog so omitted.
