SITUATION IMPROVES.

Insurance Companies Refuse to Pay for Property Lost in the Fire.

MANILA, Feb. 24.—3:50 afternoon.—The arrest of 1,200 suspects since the fire started and the extreme vigilance of the police is believed to have averted all danger of further incendiarism at present. The main fire brigade from the British cruiser "Narcissus" is landed every night to protect the British banks. The underwriters refuse to pay losses of those claiming exemption by reason of the war clause in their policies.

Four American soldiers were wounded in last night's fighting in front of Caloan and one at San Pedro. Scattering shots continue all along the line.

The situation has decidedly improved, although the Chinese are still timorous. Hundreds of applicants for Certificates are in the register's office. The natives being under the impression that this possession insures them from interference ignominious of march for arms in the streets.

HANNA CLEARED.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 24.—The Senate committee on privileges and elections has decided there is no case made in the protest against Senator Hanna and ordered his report made to the Senate. Turkey reserves the right to make a statement in the Senate, though no minority report will be made.

FAIR TOMORROW.

The weather bureau predicts for Raleigh and vicinity: Increasing cloudiness with rain Sunday; brisk easterly winds and rising temperature.

The storm in the west is developing force rapidly and is central over northern Texas. Threatening weather prevails throughout the entire Mississippi valley and west with rain at many stations, and snow at northern points. The area of high barometer has moved to the north Atlantic coast, and the weather continues cool and clear east of the Allegheny Mountains.

The remarkable predominance of southeast winds over the entire section from Texas to Minnesota indicate the wide extent of the storm in the west. So far, however, the rainfall has been light everywhere.

RAILWAY TAXATION

Motion to Strike Out Double Tax Lost

SUBSTITUTE OFFERED

Overman Offers a Resolution that Railway Commission Reassess All Railway Property, Considering Gross Receipts and Franchise.

The house met at 10 o'clock. A report was made by the special committee on ventilation, covering a proposition made by a Raleigh firm of architects to provide complete ventilation.

Bills were introduced by Gilliam for the relief of the Tarboro fire department (passed under suspension of rules) and to incorporate the town of Tam Creek, Wilson county, (also passed.) By McLean, to provide for the grant of the State institution for the deaf and dumb and blind.

Bills passed: To fix the time of holding courts in Robeson county. To settle, compromise and commute the State debt (to January 1, 1901).

RAILWAY TAX.

At 11:15 the house went into committee of the whole, for the fourth time, on the revenue bill, taking up the amendment of Julian, to strike out the income tax on railroads. Willard moved that the amendment be reported back to the house without prejudice. Holman proposed that speeches be limited to two minutes. Cannon offered to his resolution directing the railway commission to put the railroads on the tax lists on the basis of six per cent. on net income. He said his resolution was perhaps crude in language but that he adhered to the principle. McLean wanted to know whether Cannon's resolution did not take the place of Julian's amendment. Overman said Cannon's resolution was not germane to the bill. Cannon said he would withdraw it until the bill was disposed of, and that he would then re-introduce it, as it merely suggested a line of action. Overman did not want the amendment thrown back into the house and wanted the committee to dispose of it. Willard's motion prevailed. The committee sat one hour.

OVERMAN'S RESOLUTION.

Overman made a motion that the house proceed to consider the revenue bill. Overman said that he had done all he could for 16 years to make the railroads pay their full quota of the taxes. He introduced the first bill to create a railway commission. He said the democratic party has never made any pledges to railroads or to any other corporations; that the party proposes to do no injustice to the railroads or to any corporations. He declared he did not think the income tax on railroads proper. He said the Cannon resolution would let some railroads escape. He said that this legislature would select a railway commission broad, noble and broad-minded, which would put the railroads on the tax value and that they would be assessed on their franchise as well as on their property. He read a resolution. Holman wanted to know if this gave the railway commission any additional power. Overman said that it would show to the commission what this legislature and the people demanded, and that he was sure the new commission would do the proper thing.

The following is Overman's resolution: "Whereas it is claimed and generally believed that the railway property of the State is not bearing its equal proportion of taxation and whereas all the property of the State should bear its full share of the burden of government. Resolved, by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the railway commission or any body succeeding to its power, be and they are hereby directed to see as soon as practicable to revise the assessment for taxation of the entire railway property of the State taking in consideration the earnings and gross income as well as the franchise of said railroads.

"Resolved that this resolution be enforced from and after its ratification." Willard called the previous question. The call was sustained. He asked that only those sections to which there was amendments be read. The bill was then read in that shape it being the second reading. The amendments made in committee of the whole were adopted one after another.

Winston's amendment of section 34, taxing dispensaries, came up. This was a much discussed section in committee of the whole, and there was an amendment to the amendment offered by Craig to provide that all the dispensary tax shall go to schools. The section was amended as adopted.

JULIAN'S AMENDMENT LOST.

The question was then on the amendment of Julian to strike out the section which impose an income tax on railroads (a tax on gross earnings). Robinson demanded the yeas and nays on this. Julian said that after the introduction of Overman's resolution his amendment certainly ought to be adopted. Overman said he had hoped that his resolution could be in this bill. Allen, of Wayne, suggested that it be inserted in the machinery act. Craig said he understood that Overman had introduced it as an amendment to the revenue act. Overman said he would like to have it also adopted as a resolution. Overman said he would like to introduce it as an amendment to the bill. But objection was raised by Thompson, of Onslow. The speaker ruled that the roll call and Julian's amendment must be had. It was stated that the Overman resolution could come up on the third reading of the bill. There were several explanations of votes. The vote was yeas 49, nays 55. There was applause at the result.

The bill then passed second reading, 66 to 7. Overman gave notice that he would offer his resolution as substitute for the sections imposing the income tax. He also made a motion that the bill be made special order at the end of the morning hour Monday. The order was so made.

The bill for the support and maintenance of the State Guard came up as a special order. It carried an appropriation of \$16,000, salary of adjutant general \$1,000, and he is to be brigadier general of the brigade of troops when called into active service; enlistments to be for three years; Ray, of Macon, made the point that the bill had not been before the special committee on appropriation. It was so ordered.

Bills were introduced, by Council, to validate the charter and sale of the Linville River Railroad Company. By Willard, to take from the railway commission the right to tax the franchises of railroads. By Justice, to fix the time of holding courts in the 19th district. By Gilliam, to amend section 559 of the Code by saying "unless the judge be prevented from doing so by sickness or other disability." By Thompson, of Onslow, to provide for more effectually posting land.
