The storm over Texas has developed considerable force and has moved eastward to the mouth of the Mississippi. New Orleans reported a barometer of 29.88 inches. Threatening weather with rain is reported throughout the entire South; the heaviest rainfall was 2.84 inches at Galveston.

The northern storm has moved down the St. Lawrence valley. The barometer is high over the Plateau region. Low temperatures prevail from the Dakotas east to the Lakes, but no temperatures below zero are reported.
