

GREENSBORO Nov. 19.—
Commissioner of Internal Revenue Robert E. Hannogan today urged all taxpayers to determine if they are required to file either original or amended "Declarations of Estimated Income and Victory Tax on or before Decamber 15.

Explaining that only a limited of taxpayers need make any filing at this time, Mr. Hannegan suggested that everyone ascertain for himself whetner he is affected, By far the largest percentage of taxpayers have no further filings to make until the annual income and Victory tax return is due not later than March 15. 1944. However, some taxpayers who filed declarations in September have an instalment to pay December 15, for which they will be sent bills by their local Collectors of Internal Revenue.






Tax Payers To File Employment Stabili- Rocked in the Cradle of Sea Sickness
